PHASE 1

- Worship online only
- Church offices closed
- All in-person church activities canceled
- Adult Sunday School, Bible studies, small groups meeting online only
- Church meetings online only
- Church building cleaned and disinfected in preparation for resuming in-person gathering

PHASE 2

- Worship gathering in-person; limited to 80 people
- Stringent meeting restrictions (as listed on following pages)
- Adult Sunday School, Bible studies, small groups resume in-person in limited capacity
- Church offices reopen in limited capacity
- Other in-person church activities canceled or limited

PHASE 3

- Worship gathering in-person; attendance limits discretionary
- Limited meeting restrictions (as listed on following pages)
- Adult Sunday School, Bible studies, small groups meet in-person with possible restrictions
- Church offices open with normal schedule
- Other in-person church activities discretionary

PHASE 4

- Worship gathering in-person; no attendance limits
- Discretionary meeting restrictions (as listed on following pages)
- Adult Sunday School, Bible studies, small groups meet in-person with possible restrictions
- Church offices open with normal schedule
- Other in-person church activities resume with possible restrictions

PHASE 2 MEETING RESTRICTIONS

- Stringent social distancing (6 feet of space at all times)
- Audio available in café if 80 person limit exceeded
- Face masks encouraged for all able attendees as a means of demonstrating concern for those at higher risk
- Those with symptoms of illness or who have been in contact with someone ill required to stay home
- 65+ and high-risk individuals encouraged to consider staying home for their own safety
- No in-person children's ministry
- Food and drinks unavailable
- Bulletins and other materials online only
- Socially-distanced greeting time during service
- Offering basket in back of room (online giving still available)
- Hand-sanitizing stations available
- Attendees asked to keep public spaces clear before and after service
- Doors will remain open to avoid touching of handles
- Surfaces sanitized after each meeting
- Worship services and discipleship classes continue online option



PHASE 3 MEETING RESTRICTIONS

- Modest social distancing (taking necessary precautions)
- Face masks optional
- Those with symptoms of illness or who have been in contact with someone ill required to stay home
- 65+ and high-risk individuals take necessary precautions before attending
- In-person children's ministry with precautions
- Limited food and drinks
- Limited paper bulletins and other materials
- Socially-distanced greeting time during service
- Offering basket in back of room (online giving still available)
- Hand-sanitizing stations available
- Fellowship in public spaces with precautions
- Doors will remain open to avoid touching of handles
- Surfaces sanitized after each meeting
- Worship services and discipleship classes continue online option



PHASE 4 MEETING RESTRICTIONS

- Relaxed social distancing
- Those with symptoms of illness or who have been in contact with someone ill required to stay home
- Resume in-person children's ministry
- Resume shared food and drinks
- Paper bulletins and other materials available
- Resume regular greeting times
- Resume passing offering plate
- Hand-sanitizing stations available
- Resume regular fellowship before and after service
- Surfaces sanitized regularly
- Worship services and discipleship classes continue online option
